Suggested Contest Timeline for 2020-2021

Chapter Activities

August

- 1. Appoint an Essay Contest Chairman to administer the contest. The Chairman should select five or six individuals to assist him as judges
- 2. Notify the State Society Chairman of the Chapter Chairman's name, address, email and telephone number.
- 3. Receive the contest package from the State Society Chairman.
- 4. Note the *not-later-than-date* that the Chapter needs to send their winning essay to the State Essay Chairman.
- 5. Decide on Chapter-level prizes to award. Order them as required.
- 6. Establish a date that entries must be received by. Be sure to allow adequate time for judging and sending of the winning essay to the State Chairman.

September

- 7. Prepare and distribute press releases for local media as appropriate.
- 8. Distribute Contest Rules to all local area high schools and accredited home-schooling associations/groups. This can be done via mail, email, personal visits, etc.

October

9. Request medal and/or certificates from NSSAR Merchandise (SAR Store).

December and January

- 10. Receive and judge essays.
- 11. No later than January 31st submit winning essay to the OHSSAR Essay Contest Chairman.

February and March

12. Recognize the winning student (and other participants as appropriate) at an appropriate ceremony.
